

Berlin Declaration (<https://openaccess.mpg.de/Berlin-Declaration>):

1. "... free, irrevocable, worldwide, right of access ..."
2. "... complete version of the work and all supplemental materials ..."

Five A's:

- **Accuracy:** "The experiments were conducted on a modern computer ..."
- **Archiving:** "What do I know about my code from last year?"
- **Accessibility:** "The code could not be provided, because it is not functioning"
- **Automatic:** "Sorry, I mainly publish in \*insert journal here\*."
- **Ask:** "I thought the library was just for books ..."
